

International meeting within *e-Preparation Portal for Teachers-Students-Parents Including Abroad Studies* project



On February 8, 2023, the Politehnica University of Bucharest organized the international project meeting where aspects related to project management and implementation were discussed (revision of the Grant diagram, translations, manuals, etc.) and the new educational platform Digital platform for teachers-students and parents developed within the Erasmus+ project "e-Prep" (e-Preparation Portal for Teachers-Students-Parents Including Abroad Studies).

First of all, the e-prep platform prepares young students for university entrance exams across Europe. The e-prep training platform prepares high school students and students for the requirements of universities in Europe. The platform offers a summary of EU study modules with generic content about what the European Union is: its history, information about languages, cultural diversity and codes of conduct.

The platform is interactive, with participants being greeted by an Avatar that interacts in real time with them, making navigation much easier. The avatar accompanies the participant throughout the time they are active on the platform, providing support and guidance.



About the project

Project's core aim is to develop effective and efficient e-Training techniques, practical knowledge-containing materials, and feedback systems so that users are successfully adapting to the world of online learning and maintain their endeavors.

The main result of e-Prep project is an innovative digital Multilanguage portal developed to meet those needs and be used not only in the educational system of the European Union member states but also to non-European Union countries. Through the platform the users (Trainers, Parents and Students) are required to complete a questionnaire, such that the digital portal can identify their requirements and provide suggestions that would fulfill their needs. In parallel, the parents are also able to learn how to support their kids in overcoming obstacles including language difficulties, knowledge gaps, preparation requirements, and computer skills abilities depending on the courses that are provided. Moreover, the platform provides guidance to teachers on how to organize and administer online courses efficiently.

E-prep aims to correct the common misunderstandings of the EU as having one school system, that each country has its own education system although the accreditation e.g. EQVET and

ECTS standards are agreed in commonly. E-Platform will give guidance to the European existing networks and chosen national ones, whereas a foreign, outer European students in far distance can start seeking different educational opportunities. So, main objective *is to increase the influx of well prepared and competent foreign students in higher education under current available education market conditions.*
